

CLEP & DSST Testing

Availability. CLEP and DSST exams are available in over 60 subject areas and are similar to end-of-course tests offered by colleges and universities.

Acceptance. The examinations are widely accepted by colleges and universities. More than 2,900 schools recognize CLEP, and more than 1,900 schools recognize DSST.

Time Savings. Compared to spending 40 hours in a classroom, exams are only 90 to 120 minutes in length. Of course, you will still have to study for your tests, but that time may be significantly shorter if you are already strong in a particular subject.

Money Savings. Exams are free to the military for the first attempt. Civilians pay a minimum of \$85.00 per exam and an admin fee of \$25.00 which is significantly less than the cost of a three credit course from \$750 - \$1,110. The cost advantage may make the difference in your ability to finance tuition, especially if you are running out of tuition assistance or financial aid early.

Convenience. Testing is offered on base; no need to travel to an off-base location. Testing is conducted weekly at the MacDill Education Office in room 213 on Wednesdays at 9:30am.

DSST: <http://tcnet.prometric.com/dsst>. If you are a military member, create a DSST MILITARY account to indicate that you are DANTEs funded. During the registration process, use Test Center Code 7177 to identify that you are testing at MacDill. Please identify a score recipient by searching the code for your specific school.
