

General Rules

- Bay Palms Golf Courses are for the use of active duty/retired military, reserve components, DoD civilians, and their family members. Civilian guests may use the facility by requesting access to the base.
- Golfers are expected to check in with the starter at least 15 minutes prior to their scheduled tee time.
- Annual, semi-annual, or daily fees must be paid prior to play on the course. All players are required to register in the pro shop prior to play and have, in their possession, a membership card, or a receipt for the day indicating they have registered/paid the appropriate fees.
- Appropriate golf attire is expected. The wearing of military uniforms (or parts of) is prohibited, except
 during active-duty clinics. Shirts with collars and sleeves must be worn. The following attire is not
 authorized: bathing suits, gym shorts, jogging shorts, spandex pants, or any other type of form fitting
 material, cut-offs (shirt/shorts), men's tank tops, short shorts, halters, mesh see-through garments or
 any garment that exposes the bare midriff areas.
- Only golf shoes w/soft spikes, flat-soled sneakers, or tennis shoes will be permitted on the course.
- Powered golf carts are limited to two (2) riders. Individuals renting carts must be 16 years or older and have a valid driver's license. Carts will not be driven adjacent to tees and greens except on cart paths. Red-top poles are placed in front of each green to indicate where carts should return to paths.
- Use 90°rule for power carts unless otherwise posted. When carts are permitted on fairways, stay on cart path until parallel your ball, then drive straight to it. After hitting, return to cart path.
 Be a 90° driver...help protect our fairways.
- All players must have a set of clubs. Rental clubs are available through the Pro Shop.
- Limited locker rental is available on a yearly basis. \$60 a year + \$6 Key Deposit.
- Food and beverages must be purchased at the pro shop or the 8IG. Coolers are not permitted.
- Refunds will not be made for daily green fees/carts. If the course is closed due to inclement weather, a rain check may be issued by the manager or a designated representative.
- All play will start on the first holes unless permission is granted by the starter or management to do otherwise.
- Walking the South Course is allowed only with permission from the pro shop.
- Retrieving golf balls from the lakes is not permitted, except for players attempting to find their own ball during their round.
- The manager or a designated representative has the authority to request anyone to leave the premises for misconduct.
- For safety reasons, children younger than eight are not permitted on the course unless they have participated in the First Tee Program.
- Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult member unless approved for individual play by the manager.

Clinics
