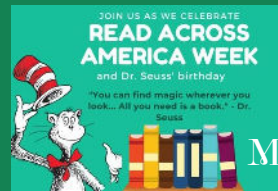

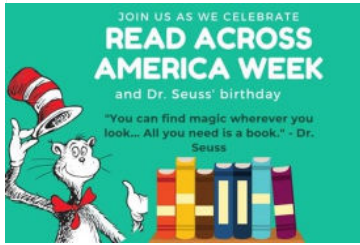

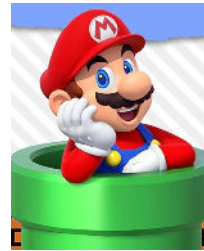

### YA Book Club

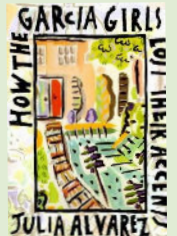
