



Resources for finding ADA Homes in Tampa

If you're an EFMP family relocating to MacDill AFB, and you plan on living on base and need an ADA home, you will need to contact the Special Needs Coordinator at EFMP-Medical for coordination. Contact here: <https://macdillfss.com/efmp-medical/>

Contact the MHO as soon as you know you are moving. The government housing team will provide you the latest information on the local housing situation and offer complete referral services and relocation assistance to make sure you find a quality place to live. Support services range from helping members understand their lease agreements and the necessity for a military release clause to assisting in resident and landlord dispute resolution, among many others.

If you need an ADA home, reach out to this office to receive a list of ADA homes in the community or to request one on base. Please know that availability on base is limited.

Harbor Bay – MacDill AFB Privatized Housing: 813-840-2600; <https://harborbayatmacdill.com/>

At MacDill, military family housing is privatized. Harbor Bay owns the family housing and is responsible for maintaining, repairing, constructing, and managing the community. In addition to your option to purchase and rent housing in the local community, you now may choose to live in privatized housing by signing a tenant lease agreement with Harbor Bay. For comprehensive information about the privatized housing community at MacDill, go to their website. It provides information you need about the homes and amenities available in the privatized housing community.

The Housing Rehabilitation Program provides financial assistance to income eligible homeowners for making needed repairs on owner-occupied homes. Financial assistance is provided in the form of a loan. Homes must be in unincorporated Hillsborough County, which is outside the City of Tampa, and the applicant must have lived in their home for two years.
