EFMP Medical, Tricare & ECHO

- Ask your losing base Military Treatment Facility for a medical warm handover to ensure continuity of care while in transition, if needed.
- Upon arrival, transfer to our Tricare East region, establish a PCM on or off base.
- Secure 3-month supply of medications needed prior to arrival.
