Air Force program: "A Home Away From Home" Certified and licensed in-home care, on- and off-base Children in care, 2 weeks to 12 years Regular care work-week, up to 50 hours Homes monitored monthly on an unannounced basis

Family Child Care well-known for their "Expanded Child Care Programs," offering specialized child care services

Expanded Child Care Programs (Specialized Child Care Services):

Extended Duty Child Care - For parent working over 50 hours to include occasional weekend duty, mission-related base exercise, Mandatory PT, Federal Holiday/Wing Down Days when CYP are closed. No cost to the parent.

Deployment Child Care - Up to 128 hours of free child care for children ages 12 and under of Active Duty, National Guard and Reserve members assigned to an AF or Joint Base AF-led installation. Services used before and/or during member's assignment in support of contingency operations.

Returning Home Child Care - Up to 16 hours of free child care for children of Active Duty, Guardsmen & Reserve members returning from a deployed status.

Child Care for PCS - Allows 20 hours of free child care for parents of ALL branches of service that are arriving to, or leaving, an Air Force base installation.

AF FCC Home Community Care – Free child care provided to Guard and Reserve members (all branches) for primary Unit Training Assembly (UTA) weekends.

AF FCC WCC - Provides free child care for families of Wounded Warriors who have short-term child care needs.

AF FCC Bereavement Care - Provides free child care for families who have an immediate family fallen military member.

FCC Emergency Medical Care - Provides child care for families experiencing medical issues with immediate family member(s).
