### COURSE UPDATES

Both courses were aerated in April. Bill's crew punched, fertilized, top dressed and rolled the greens. There are still no signs of improvement and some of them look worse. We'll try it again on June 22-24 th with more aggressive aeration (core aeration vs spike aeration). Core aeration removes soil plugs to relieve compaction and improve root growth vs spike aeration which simply punctures the soil. This will be followed by the addition of fertilizer for turf recovery.

You may have noticed that I removed the 250th anniversary flags from the South course. You cannot have or do anything special without someone ruining it. Some genius decided to buy two flags from Amazon and replace ours with theirs. That's now a red, white and blue flag that has been stolen. There is a chance you may see the remainder of them for sale in the Pro Shop.

Next time you play the South Course notice how low the water level is on the pond of #1. That pond is where we pull the water for the irrigation of the South Course. We will be cutting back on our watering to ensure we have enough for the greens. The water in the pond is gravity fed from the waste treatment pond on the left side of the fence of #1 fairway. The waste treatment plant cannot keep up with our watering demands.

### DRIVING RANGE

It's finally finished and it's beautiful!

As a reminder, please hit off the mats only. When I see that the sod has taken root, I will have a couple of days a week when we can hit off the grass.

You can put a tee directly into the mat for drivers or use the simulator tees. We will have some for sale early next month.

Curious about the Power Tees? Stop by the pro shop to make your reservation. You'll be amazed at how much cooler it is inside the Cubes with the shades drawn and the fans on.

Once we have internet capabilities at the range, we'll bring in Top Tracer or other ball tracking technology to the Cubes. That project is in the works and close to being finalized.

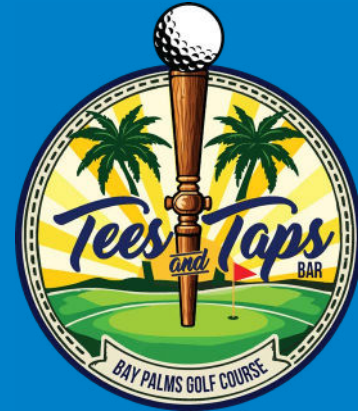
