Air Force Aid Society Spouse Employment Program

Applications for the Spouse Employment Program will be available through the Air Force Aid Society (AFAS) Application Portal **effective January 3, 2023.**

ELIGIBILITY: Spouses of active-duty Air Force personnel, including Reserve and Air National Guard activated on a Title 10 order for the duration of their approved training.

- Program provides entry-level job training with a goal to help secure immediate and viable employment.
- Eligible spouses may receive up to \$2,500 for short-term classes/certifications (3-12 weeks) that would lead to employment.
- Required documents include member's active duty or Title 10 orders, student's military ID, proof of enrollment and cost of tuition for the program/certification.
