MEMORANDUM FOR 6TH FORCE SUPPORT SQUADRON SKEET RANGE

SUBJECT: Weapons Handling for Use of the Skeet Range

1. This facility will be in compliance with the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, and Firearm (BATF) and also in accordance with AFMAN 91-201, "Explosives Safety Standards", for the safety of competitors, field personnel and spectators. Please read the rules below and sign and date acknowledging that you understand and will abide by the rules. If you do not abide by these rules you will be expelled from the Skeet Range.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

2. On any part of the Skeet Range Grounds, safe gun handling techniques are mandatorily used at all times. It is the duty of the field personnel to enforce safety procedures and safe gun handling. The following will be enforced:
- a. **All personnel** (including shooters, trap personnel, guests, etc.) must wear some form of eye and ear protection on the Skeet Range.
 - b. No gun shall be loaded until the shooter is on the shooting station. A loaded weapon is considered as having any part of any shell in any gun.
 - c. Throwing of gun will result in immediate expulsion from the Skeet Range.
 - d. Test shots **will not** be permitted without the permission from one of the Skeet Range personnel on site.
 - e. The loaded gun shall be kept pointed in a direction that will not endanger the lives of shooters, field personnel or spectators.
 - f. When not on the shooting station, the gun shall be carried with breech end open and empty. Fixed breech (double barrels including over-and-under and side-by-sides) will be broken open and empty.
 - g. When the shooter is on the shooting station and ready to shoot and delay occurs, such as equipment breakdown, the gun shall be opened and all shells extracted.
 - h. The loading of more than 2 shells in the gun **shall not** be allowed.
 - i. Any shooter whose gun accidentally discharges twice within one round for mechanical reasons shall be required to change guns or, if time permits, have his/her gun repaired, before continuing to shoot the round or subsequent rounds.
 - j. Please pick up your shell casings after you are finished firing.
 - k. No spectators shall be allowed on the range (beyond sidewalk) while the range is hot.
 - l. The use of drugs and/or alcohol is **strictly prohibited** prior or while on the Skeet Range.
 - m. No smoking within 50 feet of the facility.
 - n. Ammo stored in the facility will not exceed 5,000 rounds.
