HOW TO REGISTER

CURRENT YOUTH CENTER MONTHLY MEMBERS

- May register online using their existing CYPBMS Parent Portal Account on **April 27th**
**Must have current flu shot.*

NON-MEMBERS

- Must contact the Youth Center at 6fss.fsy.yip@us.af.mil to create an on-line account to register.
- Once all registered information has been completed in the online portal, patrons may sign-up online beginning **May 1, 2026.**
- **PLEASE NOTE:** For new patrons, a current flu shot must be provided to complete the registration process by uploading it to the online portal or emailing it to 6fss.fsy.yip@us.af.mil. Your registration will not be processed without also completing the CYPBMS parent portal requirements of uploading payment information along with filling out everything with a red asterisk.

A monthly membership of \$60 for Pre-Teens and \$25 for Teens is required to attend Open Recreation from 12-6PM
